More and more men are joining our weekly Men's Small Groups for daily encouragement, discipleship and accountability. Throughout the year we have Men's breakfasts, Daddy/Daughter date nights and a host of opportunities to get connected with other men and find a way to fulfill God's purpose in our lives! Heart Kids

The Heart Kids; where our goal is to help kiddos be a People after God's own Heart. We cultivate this each week by providing a fun learning experience.

Heart Youth

This year was a great year for our students and leaders. We have over 70 first time guests this year and we saw over 120 people make a commitment to Jesus and have watched our leadership team continue to grow. Offering childcare for leaders has been extremely fruitful for the ministry as a whole. This has allowed us to have more well developed leaders join youth over the past year! We have many students going all in and walking with leaders in fruitful discipleships. With a focus being put on worship and the giftings in our leaders over the last year, we are seeing a deep, and lasting, impact on both the leaders and students that attend on a wednesday night. We believe that Heart Youth is a place where students can come as they are, and leave forever changed! We are very excited to see what God has in store this next year!

Heart Young Adults

The way that the Heart Young Adults attempts to accomplish being a people after God's own heart is by having a vision to build a healthy community of disciples. Over this past year, the Young Adult ministry has seen continued growth toward that vision. We have continued to expand our team and relaunched monthly Team Nights

to grow in relationship and teach practical leadership skills. We also launched young adult small groups! This was a vision long in the making and our community was hungry for it. We now have a large percentage of the young adult congregation plugged into small groups. We've also seen huge growth in the desire of our young adults to have a mentor and be poured into, which is huge!

We continue to partner with the Market at the Heart to serve a home-cooked meal each week to start our gatherings. The Community Room is almost bursting at the seams and we will likely have to move into the sanctuary soon. From April 2023 - March 2024, we've had at least 56 people commit or recommit their lives to Christ! In that same timespan, we saw 186 first-time guests on Thursday nights! We are very excited for the future of Heart Young Adults!

Heart for the Nations

Heart for the Nations seeks to go deeper and wider than what one may think of when they hear "missions ministry." We want people to know God's heart for the world, and that we can each play a vital and unique role in the gospel going to the ends of the earth. This past year we were able to cultivate deep relationships with our missionaries, give an additional \$10,000 to brothers and sisters on the mission field, and link Heart of the City members to various short-term trips. We also connected the church body to what God is doing around the world through On-Mission weekend, globally-minded events and missional dinners, and regular monthly prayer and worship meetings. Our goal is to increasingly connect with the congregation and let them know that Heart for the Nations is not just for people who want to go on 'mission trips,' but is for people who love Jesus, are interested in other cultures, and want to see God's love transform the world.

Market at The Heart

At the Market we believe in victory over ALL circumstances through relationship and the love of Jesus Christ. Not only are we believing it, we are seeing it! God is using the Market in a mighty way. Relationships are being built amongst our team, with our guests, and with every new organization the Lord brings us in partnership with. In this past year, we were able to bless the community with over 64,000 pounds of food. We served over 5,600 individuals at our location. Praise the Lord there has been no shortage of volunteer interest. Between all of our volunteers, we accumulated over 10,000 volunteer hours. People are coming hungry and are leaving fed in more than one way. It has been so beautiful watching all these resources and hours being used to honor and glorify our Lord.

Heart Creative (Production)

In the past fiscal year we saw a new level of immense growth in our production team. We have experienced an increasing level of excellence in our team with camera work, video switching, projections, lighting, and sound. It is so beautiful to see the impact Heart of the City has on our community and our world. We saw a slight decrease in podcast plays to 16,663 plays and we saw a great increase on Youtube with 12,900 watch hours and 3,210 subscribers! It is so beautiful to be a part of the reach that The Heart has outside the four walls of the church!

Heart Creative (Audio/Music)

This past year we have been extremely intentional about the songs we sing and how we create set lists for corporate worship. This means we have prioritized songs with praise heavy themes above everything else. We've even pulled out several oldies to help accomplish this at times.

I believe that we are made right when all of our attention is off of ourselves, and placed on Jesus. Problems get smaller, distractions disappear, and our hearts align with Heaven.

Heart Creative released Presence (Heaven) on all music streaming platforms and hope to release several more this year.

We continue to meet once a month for Creative Community nights and kicked off something new called "Team Nights." We have a team night once a month and

those rotate between our music team, production team and then a combined team night where we all come together. These nights are hosted in our home and have shown to be extremely fruitful.

We relaunched one of the key teams within the Heart Creative called Performing Arts, led by Jannelle White. You may have seen performances during Christmas and Easter, but in March they launched a weekly expression of the team that serves each weekend as part of our gatherings.

Our heart is to raise up worshipers and dance revivalists who operate with excellence and anointing in ministering to God and to people through dance. We focus on equipping dancers to partner with Holy Spirit and with each other, teaching them to move from the place of knowing their identity in Christ. We help each dancer grow in their individual creative expression, and we train them to minister together as modern day Levites, hearing God's voice and expressing His heart through dance. The Heart Creative exists to facilitate significant encounters between God and people through creative expression. Our goal in worship is to minister to Jesus first and foremost in everything we do.
